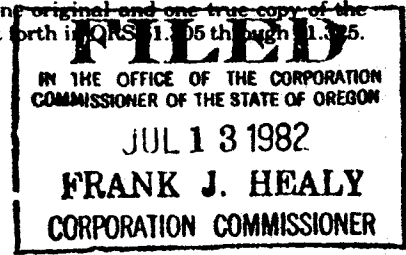

One or more natural persons of the age of 18 years or more, a domestic or foreign corporation, a partnership or an association may incorporate a nonprofit corporation by signing and verifying Articles of Incorporation and delivering one original and one true copy of the articles to the Corporation Commissioner. The procedure for the formation of nonprofit corporations is set forth in ORS 61.05 through 61.325. See ORS 61.311 for the content of Articles of Incorporation.

THE EATING AND DRINKING SOCIETY OF OREGON, INC.

The undersigned natural person(s) of the age of eighteen years or more, a domestic or foreign corporation, a partnership or an association acting as incorporators under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Law, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE I** The name of this corporation is The Eating and Drinking Society of Oregon, Inc.

(The corporate Name cannot contain any word or phrase which indicates or implies that it is organized for any purpose other than one or more of the purposes contained in its articles of incorporation; and cannot contain the word "cooperative". See ORS 61.071.)

and its duration shall be perpetual

**ARTICLE II** The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To help and guide those who would like a better understanding, appreciation and interest in the exciting world of gastronomy, ("the art, or science of good eating").

As a recognized "Bread Basket" and viticulture region of the world, we Oregonians should delight in and expound upon our fortunate epicurean heritage

"The Corporation may engage in any lawful activity, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61".

(It is not necessary to set forth in the articles any of the corporate powers enumerated in ORS 61.061. It is sufficient to state, either alone or with other purposes, "That the corporation may engage in any lawful activity, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61"; however, it is desirable to state the primary purpose of the corporation in conjunction with such statement.)
